DRIVING DIRECTIONS to Decatur Conference Center and Hotel, centrally located in Illinois, Decatur is only a few hours drive from Chicago, St. Louis and Indianapolis. **From Chicago O'Hare Airport:** Take I-55 South to Bloomington, IL. From Bloomington take US Route 51 South. Follow US Route 51 South to I-72 West. Follow I-72 West to exit 133A, the second exit for Decatur (Reads US Route 36E). Continue ½ mile on US Route 36 to the traffic light. At the traffic light turn right, then left into the Decatur Conference Center. **From St. Louis Lambert Airport:** Merge onto I-70E, merge onto 170N, merge onto 270E toward Chicago, merge onto I-55N, take I-55 North to Springfield, IL, from Springfield take I-72 East. Judge or Presenter Biographies

- **Keith Boeke** started competing in obedience in 1974 with a Sheltie who became one of the first dogs titled as an OTCh in AKC. Keith has trained 3 Shelties since then earning UD and CDXs in AKC, as well as Canadian CDs, CDXs, UD and a Canadian OTCh. Keith also has titled in UKC obedience, earning U-CDs, U-CDXs, a U-UD and a U-OCH. Keith is a member of Forest City Dog Training Club (AKC) and Rock Valley Kennel Federation (UKC). He was recently made a lifetime member of Forest City DTC where he is also an instructor of all levels of obedience and rally. Keith is licensed to judge ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America), 4-H and UKC obedience trials, and AKC Rally. He became a UKC Rep. last year and will be working with UKC on starting a Rally program.
- **Sandra Boeke** began her obedience competition showing in 1971 with a Sheltie, Gine. She finished her CD title at the age of 9 months with one HIT. She currently has earned 6 AKC CDs, 4 CDXs, 4 UD, 4 UKC CDs, 3 UKC CDXs, 2 UKC UD, 1 UKC OCH, 1 U-AGCH, 4 CAN CDs, 2 CAN CDXs, 2 CAN UD, 2 CAN OTCh, 2 Dog World Awards and 1 Canadian Dog World Award. All titles were earned with Shelties with many placings, HITs and a 200 score in UKC Open. Also, Sandra has been listed in the Top 25 Obedience for Shelties. Sandra began judging in 1972 with ASCA and 4-H. She began judging UKC obedience in 1993 while still judging ASCA and 4-H in Illinois and Wisconsin. Sandra is a lifetime member of Forest City DTC (AKC) where she is an instructor. Sandra also belongs to Rock Valley Kennel Federation (UKC). Sandra is looking forward to judging for the UDC.
- **Nancy Christensen** has been hooked on the Doberman since 1974, beginning with Clyde A Scope UD and Silent Sentry's Renaissance, CD, WAC. In her first foray into breeding, she produced DPCA Top 20 winner, CH Renejade The Jazz Singer CD ROM; who produced Nancy's foundation bitch, CH Alpha Omega's Tushima UD ROM. Nancy also bred Am/Can CH Renejade All American Jazz CDX ROM AG1; CH Renejade Go For The Gold CDX ROM; OTCH Renejade American Mystic UDX; Renejade Swing On A Star CDX WAC; and UDC CH Renejade Windsor v Jazlin CDX WAC Sch3 ZTP CGC VCX (Robin will be 15 in March!). Other breedings have produced get titled in tracking, fly ball, agility, obedience, dancing, Schutzhund and SAR certifications. Nancy is the UDC Director of Judges, a UDC Conformation/Breed Survey Judge, an AKC Doberman conformation judge and serves on the DPCA Board of Directors.
- **Shirley Hammond** has greater than 25 years of Search and Rescue (SAR) experiences and has certified three of her own dogs in area search, cadaver, disaster, evidence and water. She has mentored many teams through the SAR certification process as an instructor and evaluator for the California Rescue Dog Association, Santa Clara Medical Examiner-Coroner's Canine Specialized Support Team, the State of California Office of Emergency Services (OES) Cadaver Certification. Shirley is a member of and instructor for the CA OES/FEMA Urban Search and Rescue Response System and a member of the California OES Canine Search Specialist Working Group. She is a life member of NASAR and co-founded the UDC SARDOBE working group. Her email address is shirham@sbcglobal.net.
- **Butch Henderson** has over 30 years experience training, breeding, and competing with his working dogs. He and his Doberman, Agir, won both the 2004 AWDF and 2005 DVG national championships and received high protection honors at the 2005 IDC World Championship. He has nationally titled multiple breeds in Schutzhund, including Bouviers, Dobermans, German Shepherds, and Rottweilers. He has completely titled several high-caliber competition schutzhund dogs from basic to Schutzhund III and has helped literally hundreds of clients reach their schutzhund and basic dog training goals. Agir is the first and only Doberman to be a DVG national champion and in 1996, Butch's dog Brinks became the first and only Bouvier to capture the same honor. Butch has been the training director of the Commonwealth Working Dog Club for 14 years. He was the 2001 Captain of the U.S. Rottweiler team in Italy, and was a bomb dog handler in NYC and Baltimore. Butch represented the U.S. 4 times in Germany at the Deutsche Meisterschaft, once at the IDC World Doberman Championship, and was selected to be on the USA team at the 2004 FCI World Championship.
- **Roar Kjønstad** is currently the manager of Scandinavia's largest dog school, Oslo Hundeskole (www.oslo-hundeskole.no). He has been active in dog sports since 1983, mainly with Dobermanns. He has trained and trialed Dobermanns in IPO/SchH, SAR and Obedience, titling 5 Dobermanns from SchH I to SchH III in 6 years. He is the training director of Stubberudmyra Brukshund Klub since 1996, he's been a trial helper since 1999, doing helper work at several large trials. The National Training Director for helpers since 2001, he's responsible for educating, training and approval of trial helpers. He's been the team captain of several FCI, WUSV and Nordic Championships, and a former member of Kennel Club Working Dog Committee and the Dobermann Club board. Roar has been an FCI judge since 2003 and judged several National trials. He's been a mental test judge since 2004. Roar has been influenced mainly by Belgian and German philosophy. Trains and attends frequently in the most successful clubs in Europe and gives seminars regularly both national and international.
- **Bunny Lanning** titled her first Doberman when she was 15 years old. This was the beginning of a life long love affair with the Doberman breed. Since then she has trained Dobermans to Utility, Excellent Agility, Schutzhund, Tracking, Herding titles, and a Certified Police Dog, and has bred several Conformation Champions, with many working titles, under the Lothlorien prefix. A founding member of UDC, Bunny has had the honor of being the President of the United Doberman Club for almost three years, and a board member for many more. She has actively served as a Certified Evaluator for Therapy Dogs International for 17 years. She takes the UDC mission very seriously; working, testing and breeding for the dog that is the total Doberman, sound in mind and body. Bunny has judged the UDC Temperament Tests at the National on three other occasions.
- **Butch MacDonald & Cecilia Ringstrom** have been involved in dogs shows for nearly 40 years. They have been successful breeders of Doberman Pinschers under the Starstorm prefix, also Papillons and Toy Poodles. Both were all breed professional handlers for 23 years before starting their judging career. As handlers, they handled many top dogs in Canada and have attained many Best in Show wins on client's dogs. Since starting their judging career, they have been fortunate to have judged not only all across Canada, but have judged our wonderful breed in the USA (including specialties Westminster weekend). They have also judged all breeds in Chile, Hong Kong, Australia twice, Beijing China, Thailand, Brazil, Argentina, Indonesia, South Africa, Sweden and consider themselves fortunate to have been able to have judged Dobermanns in many countries of the world. Both reside in Canada.
- **Dr. Nancy Morris DVM, Diplomate ACVIM** received her BS in Medical Technology from the Oregon Institute of Technology, graduating Magna Cum Laude. She received her DVM degree in 1990 from Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine. During veterinary school, she served as a research technician in a project to validate echocardiography in dogs as a means to determine left ventricular volumes and ejection fraction using a modified Simpson's approximation technique. After graduation, Dr. Morris spent 7 years in private practice and then a 2 year residency at Angell Memorial Animal Hospital in cardiopulmonary medicine. She is board certified by ACVIM in cardiology. Dr. Morris is currently active in cardiovascular research having completed a multi-center FDA/CVM clinical trial for Pimobendan (phosphodiesterase III inhibitor drug) to treat congestive heart failure in dogs. She has served as a cardiology consultant to biotech, medical device manufacturers and pharmaceutical development companies. Dr. Morris has been very involved with Dobermanns and has performed hundreds of echocardiograms and holter monitors across the U.S./Canada.
- **John Soares** is an experienced Doberman trainer and handler and UDC National Training Director. John handled a Doberman, Topper to a 4th place IDC World Championship placement in 2005. They also became the first Doberman team to ever qualify for the FCI for Italy. At the qualifying trial, John was HIT obedience, with a score of 96. As a professional dog trainer, John has had the unique opportunity to have lived in both the U.S.A. and Europe. His ability has brought him recognition in both continents. He has experience training and trialing different breeds; he has also experienced many styles of training.

MONDAY WORKSHOPS and ACTIVITIES at Progress City. See schedule for times.

•**Tracking Fundamentals/Problem Solving with Anne Rammelsberg.** Fee: \$10 per dog/handler Anne Rammelsberg will cover tracking fundamentals and problem solving for both IPO and AKC tracking. She earned High in Trial Tracking at UDC with two different H.O.T Dobermans and titled Boris to IPO3/SchH3, TDX, FH2, and IPO-FH. Bring a hungry dog and delicious bait! UDC OBEDIENCE TRIAL #1 under Judge Sandra Boeke at Progress City

UDC obedience requires that teams demonstrate mastery of basic skills (Novice classes) or advanced skills (Open & Utility). **Please read the obedience rules in the UDC Performance Manual available at <http://www.uniteddobermanclub.com/> before entering.** Novice A is for Dobermans who do not have any obedience titles in AKC, UKC, CKC, other registry, or U.S.A./DVG. Note that dogs holding a "BH" or any Schutzhund title must enter Novice B. Novice B entries can already hold a title. Veteran Novice is a non-regular class for dogs 7 years or older. Veteran's Novice is a non-regular class, therefore scores from this class are not eligible for High in Trial. UDC allows dog/handlers to enter multiple classes, such as Novice and Open in the same trials, assuming they have the proper qualifications. Note: **There will be no refunds for a bitch in season if she is not allowed to compete.** Bitches in season will be allowed to compete under the following conditions: 1. She must be the last dog to show after all classes are completed prior to HIT being awarded. 2. She is not eligible for run offs 3. She must be kept out of the obedience area until called for her class. 4. Ribbons for the class in which she is entered will be awarded after she has completed her routine 5. A demonstration dog must be available if there is only one bitch in season. In the event of two-day trial, she will only be able to show in the last trial unless a separate obedience ring is available. Notify Pam Burns, obedience chair, as soon as you determine your entered bitch will be in season so that the chances that you will be allowed to show will be maximized.

UDC TEMPERAMENT TESTS under Judge Bunny Lanning at Progress City

The UDC requires that all Conformation entries take a UDC TT prior to showing. Dogs need not pass to show. TT's are divided by age and level of training: PTT for the Puppy Classes, YTT for the Youth Classes, ATT for Adult Classes or STT for the Sport Class. Dogs that have the AFFB, GFFB or D-ZTP are automatically eligible for the Sport Class without taking the SST. Dogs who have the FFB do not have to take the ATT. See the UDC Breed Manual available at <http://www.uniteddobermanclub.com/> for additional details. Non-UDC registered dogs must have proof of titles and papers available for review. All entrants will receive a written evaluation as proof of participation.

BRIEF UDC CONFORMATION RULES & ENTRY REGULATIONS

All entrants are required to take the UDC temperament test prior to showing. Handlers are responsible for presenting proper UDC TT or UDC Breed Survey critique to the Conformation stewards prior to their class or a CC will be withheld. Dogs may fail the TT and still participate, but cannot earn a CC. Although it is recommended that dogs be registered with UDC and have a UDC Record Book, Dobermans in other National registries may show. All dogs will receive a critique. Classes are divided by sex and age: **Puppy** (6 to 12 months old); **Youth** (12 to 24 months old). There will be a **Best Puppy** and **Best Youth** plus **Best Opposite Puppy** and **Best Opposite Youth**. Adult classes are for dogs over 24 months of age. **Open** class is for all adults. **Working** class is for adults who hold a BH, Agility, Obedience, SAR, Guide Dog, Therapy or Tracking qualification. **Sport** class entrants must have a SchHA, SchH, Brevet, French Ring, or IPO qualification. **Veterans** class is for adults 7 years or older who hold a working or sport qualification and they may be spayed/neutered. **Altered** are non-regular classes for spayed and neutered dogs who then compete for **Best Altered**. Dogs over 7 years may enter EITHER Altered or Veterans class, but not both. **Champion** class is for UDC or other recognized champions (AKC/CKC/DV/VDH) that are adults, have a working or sport qualification, and have passed the ATT, STT or UDC Breed Survey. Winners Class is open to highest placed E-rated dogs in Adult classes that have also passed the ATT, STT or Breed Survey.

UDC BREED SURVEYS at Progress City under Judge Nancy Christensen

The UDC Breed Survey program has been revamped and updated to better meet the needs of our members. One conformation standard will be used, the UDC standard with the following modifications, 1) No more than 2 missing teeth. 2) Veterinarian certification will be accepted as proof of lost teeth. 3) Uncropped and undocked dogs will not be penalized. 4) Spayed/Neutered dogs are permitted to test. The Breed Survey Basic "BSB" uses a protection scenario similar to the ATT. The Breed Survey Advanced "BSA" uses the protection scenario that includes attack out of the blind with stick hits and a courage test. A complete description of the revised Breed Survey is available at http://www.uniteddobermanclub.com/breed/breed_survey.html. The same health tests must be submitted for the BSB and BSA. **Copies of the following documents MUST accompany Breed Survey entry: working title, hip certificate (OFA or equivalent), vWD DNA, thyroid test (within 18 months). The CERF (within 18 months) and/or echocardiogram (within 18 months) may be turned in with entry OR at a later date.**

Each Doberman entered must also be UDC registered and have permanent identification (tattoo or microchip), have at least a BH for the BSA, a working title for the BSB (see UDC Conformation Rules).

Copies of the supporting documents must accompany Breed Survey entry. Online entries must mail copies of the required documentation to Julie Ferado at the address below, prior to the April 25th Closing Date. Additional copies of all required documentation must be taken to the test site with UDC Reg. papers & UDC Book.

NATIONAL UDC TRACKING TEST and IPO TRACKING under FCI Judge Roar Kjønstad Times/locations: TBA

There are six levels of tracking available in addition to the IPO tracking: T1, T2, T3, FH1, FH2, and FH3. The UDC is offering the FH3 for the fourth time in the US! At this time, the FH3 is a special UDC Club title only. All tracks are evaluated for precision similar to IPO/Schutzhund. A BH (minimum) is required for entry into T1 or FH1. Details on availability can be found at the UDC web site. The FH1 and FH2 will follow the rules of the United Schutzhund Clubs of America, issued on January 2003 and updated on or before March 2004.
